Sensory Development



Encourage children to create their own sensory bottles with the equipment provided. Talk about the different textures and materials and predict how these materials might act when put in water. Compare these predictions to the behaviour of the materials.

Exploratory Development



Facilitate the sorting activity and encourage children to talk about each object, deciding which area it should be sorted into and what risks it poses to us. As an extension, ask the children what should be done with each object. Can it be washed? Should it be left outside?

Creative Development



Encourage the children to create sand pictures that represent how they play in the sand. Talk about the different materials available for this project and how each child uses them to represent their ideas, thoughts and feelings.

Dramatic Play

Observe how children role play with the dolls in an 'outside' area. What do they do in each area? Encourage talk about the different spaces and the activities confined to each space. This could be a good opportunity to consolidate learning about playing in LeadSmart spaces.

Turn to the 'Playing LeadSmart' page in the children's activity booklets and encourage the children to trace and colour the pictures with their preferred utensils. Talk about the colours they are using for each. Talk about each picture and how it correlates to our LeadSmart learning.
